## COVID-19 VACCINE AND VACCINE ADMINISTRATION CODES

### SUMMARY

On November 10, 2020, the American Medical Association (AMA) announced new procedure codes for the COVID-19 vaccines and vaccine administration.

On December 11, 2020, the U.S. Food and Drug Administration issued an [Emergency Use Authorization \(EUA\) for the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 Vaccine](#) for the prevention of COVID-19 for individuals 16 years of age and older. Review Pfizer's [Fact Sheet for Healthcare Providers Administering Vaccine \(Vaccination Providers\)](#) regarding the limitations of authorized use.

### KEY DETAILS

Vaccine procedure code 91300 is informational only while the vaccine is distributed to providers free of charge.

Providers should reference the table below when submitting claims for vaccine administration on or after December 11, 2020:
