







Community Health Choice Program Details

Program Launch Date	June 28 th , 2023 (Maternity) and October 25 th , 2023 (NICU)
Who is Eligible? (Maternity)	All biologically female health plan members, ages 13 to 55, regardless of risk level
Who is Eligible? (NICU)	All infants with a NICU admission will be managed by ProgenyHealth for UM and CM services
Program Duration (Maternity)	Conception up to 12-months postpartum (or loss of health plan eligibility, whichever comes first)
Program Duration (NICU)	Birth through infant's first birthday
Health Plan Line(s) of Business	CHC STAR (Medicaid), CHC CHIP Perinate (Chip-P, Medicaid), CHC Marketplace/Affordable Care Act
Cost to Members?	\$0 There is no additional cost to the member, and there is no prior authorization required
How Can Members Enroll? (Maternity)	Members may self-enroll by downloading the Maternity app (see flyer for details) or speaking with a ProgenyHealth team member. Members will need: • Full name • Date of birth • Health Plan Member ID Progeny Health will also make outreach attempts to identified pregnant / postpartum members. And, you and your team can make a simple referral via sFax
