SFY 2025 APPOINTMENT AVAILABILITY VISION PROVIDER STUDY - PROVIDER DIRECTORY REQUEST DUE OCT. 17

BACKGROUND

HHSC, in coordination with the external quality review organization (EQRO), conducts the Appointment Availability Vision Care Study. The study is conducted by the Institute for Child Health Policy at the University of Florida – the external quality review organization for Texas Medicaid and CHIP. HHSC is beginning work on the SFY2025 Appointment Availability Vision Care Provider study.

HHSC requests member-facing directory information to conduct the fielding of the study.

SUMMARY OF REQUEST

The attached template must be completed with provider directory information for vision care providers only. The template contains example data and instructions. Delete the example data and provide a list of all vision care providers in the member facing provider directory.

Do not alter the template and complete all fields for which information is available.

ACTION

Complete all fields and do not alter the template. Upload the completed template to the Ad Hoc Deliverables page in TexConnect. The completed template is due no later than October 17, 2024.

- Go to Ad Hoc Deliverables, located under “Deliverables” on the home page of TexConnect
- You must have the “MCO Adhoc Deliverable Inquiry” and “MCO Adhoc Deliverable Upload” roles to access and upload these deliverables
- Find the associated Ad Hoc Deliverable name – SFY 2025 Appointment Availability Vision Provider Directory – and use the upload button to upload your completed template
